

#### **CASAC Initial Certification 350 Course**

The Helio Health Training Institute is an approved OASAS Training provider for the delivery of the full CASAC 350 hour training for CASAC Certification.

Taking all 4 sections on a Tuesday and Thursday evenings only this course will take approximately 18 months to complete. Typically, classes run from 4-7pm in the evening. Please note, there are additional assignments and tests to complete outside of class time and students are expected to meet grading and attendance standards in order to pass the course. In order to offer an expedited course we also deliver sections on Friday mornings. Taking classes in the evening and on Friday mornings reduces the course to 12 months.

During 2019, we will continue to pilot online CASAC classes. These courses are open to individuals who have at least 6 months working in SUD treatment and have at least an associate's degree. All online participants must have a computer Laptop or desktop, a webcam and a microphone set up in order to access this course. Students will follow the same curriculum as in-person students and be expected to complete the same assignments. All classes are delivered live and in real time with student's able to interact with the instructor and their classmates. All applicants will be asked to participate in a brief screening interview to ensure that they understand the course requirements and are appropriate for the course. These interviews can take place in person or over the phone.

Completion of 350 certification classes will not count toward the work hours requirement that is set by OASAS and varies depending on your qualifications. Further information on this can be found at:

If you have already submitted an application to OASAS and only require certain parts of a module or modules, we can work with you to tailor the program to meet your needs. Our hourly rates are \$9 for employees and \$13 for the general public.

Finally, we recognize that taking these courses is a significant financial investment. We are able to help by offering payment plans should the need arise. In order to access a payment plan please contact the training institute prior to completing this application. Our payment plans are tailored to each student and carry not interest. Payment plans split the cost of each section into monthly payments. Payment plans only run for the duration of each section so if your section runs from September to the following January you will be expected to pay a 10% deposit to secure your place on the course, then make five monthly payment to pay off the balance.

If a payment plan is still beyond your means you might consider contacting either ACCESS-VR or CNY works to enquire about funding through those organizations. Both organizations have funded students in the past. Unfortunately as a private training institute we are unable to accept other student loans to cover the cost of CASAC training at this time.
